MAINTENANCE

The maintenance team have been busy over the summer break.

The bar and kitchen have been deep cleaned;

The carpet has been stretched and new gripper installed around the rink edges;

New Honours boards have been mounted in the bar/kitchen area;

The existing score board system is failing and will therefore be replaced shortly to a modern system with much more flexibility. More news to follow in August;

The gutters have been causing problems with blockages but we are working to resolve this;

The lighting on rink 8 and walkway has been damaged by water ingress following heavy rain. This is also being addressed;

A visit from a fire officer has brought up some required changes, mainly in emergency lighting and doors, which the team are working on;

Part of the Licensing application required us to install a CCTV camera in the bar area which is in progress;

New lighting will shortly be trialed in the main arena;

The information screen in the lounge is faulty and will be replaced with the screen currently in the main arena when the new scoreboard system is installed.

As you'll see, the team are very busy making improvements ready to welcome you back soon. We're looking forward to the new season!
